At the outset, the Registrar extended a warm welcome to the Chairman and all the members for the second Special Meeting of the Academic Council and requested the Vice Chancellor to conduct the meeting.

The Vice Chancellor formally welcoming the Members to the meeting briefed them about the academic and developmental activities of the University. He also explained about the plans of starting a few PG Degree and PG Diploma Courses relevant to Rural Development and Panchayat Raj from the coming academic year 2018-19. The Vice Chancellor sought the suggestions and guidance from the members on the proposed courses in the University.

Thereafter, the agenda was taken up for consideration.

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Subject No. 1: To consider and approve introduction of some Postgraduate, Certificate, Diploma and PG Diploma Courses - reg

Reference Note:

The Karnataka State Rural Development and Panchayat Raj University has started functioning from the academic year 2017-18. To begin with the University has started the following Post-graduate Courses from the academic year 2017-18.

Chapter V of the Act deals with the provisions for making the Regulations and Ordinances under Sections 56 and 57, respectively. Under Section 56 (2) of the Act, the Academic Council shall have the power to propose regulations on all matters specified in clauses (a) to (g) of sub-section (1) and matters incidental and related thereto in this regard.

Under Section 57(2) of the Act, the Academic Council may propose the Ordinances to the Executive Council and the Executive Council shall not have power to amend the draft of any Ordinances proposed by the Academic Council but it may reject the proposal or return the draft to the Academic Council for reconsideration, either in whole or in part together with such amendments as the Executive Council may suggest.

With this background, the following Ordinance framed by the First Vice Chancellor under the relevant provisions of the Act is placed before the Academic Council for consideration and approval.

Ordinance:

1. The Ordinances Governing the Choice Based Credit System for the Two Years (Four Semesters) Masters Degree Programmes in the various Schools of the Karnataka State Rural Development and Panchayat Raj University, Gadag, 2017-18.

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Resolution:

After perusal of the proposed PG and PG Diploma courses to be offered from academic year 2018-19, the members have expressed that the new courses be started considering the availability of required infrastructure facilities and availability of faculty in each of the courses and good opportunities for the upcoming graduates. The Chairman, explained in detail the infrastructure arrangements like required classrooms, hostels etc in Gadag and availability of good guest faculty/ Honorary/ Visiting faculty to teach these courses and the plans of regular recruitment. After, detailed deliberations it was resolved to start the following additional PG courses in addition to the existing five PG courses from the coming academic year 2018-19. The Council also resolved to approve the Ordinance.

- 2. M.Sc. Economics (Development Economics)
- 3. M.Sc. Food Science and Technology

It was resolved to add additional specialisation of "Community Health" to the M.S.W. program

It was also resolved that the Ordinance pertaining to PG Diploma courses be prepared and submitted for approval of the Academic Council in its next meeting.
