‘Developing infrastructure in rural areas will help us prosper’

“DEVELOPING basic infrastructure in rural areas will help the nation prosper,” Vivekananda Youth Movement founder R Balasubramaniam said on Monday.

At the first convocation address of Karnataka State Rural Development and Panchayat Raj (KSRDPR) University, Balasubramanyam said, “If villages are improved, the nation is developed. It can be ensured through the Panchayat Raj system.”
