



Guidelines to KSRDPR University students during Examinations

To ensure the health, safety and security of the students, faculty and staff following guidelines needs to be strictly followed during examinations:

1. It is the responsibility of students, who belongs to other states to arrive well before (One Week) commencement of Examinations and follow the rules of Government of Karnataka issued time to time.
2. Downloading of "Arogya Setu" App is mandatory for every Student of the University.
3. Admission to the University is restricted, admit/identity cards issued to the students should be treated as a pass for the movement of students.
4. All students should reach the exam hall before one hour and wear mask compulsorily.
5. Cleanliness, hygienic conditions and social distancing as per safety and health advisories of the concerned government departments should be strictly followed.
6. The students should sanitize their hands before and after signing the Invigilation Dairy.
7. Students having symptoms of fever, cough and cold should bring into the notice of Chief Superintendent in advance and for such students arrangements can be made to sit in a separate room.
